- 1. Faith called this meeting for clarification on charity quilts. The meeting began at 7 pm.**
- 2. Faith wanted to know if the guild had any left-over batting for these quilts. Wendy said she has some but not a lot Wendy plans on bringing this batting to the next guild meeting. Faith wondered what she should do if more batting were necessary. Wendy said she ordered hers from an American company with a discount but was charged a shipping fee. Faith said she is planning on going down to Peterborough on the weekend and will be going to the Bethany Quilt Store. She is able to purchase a bolt of 30 yards x 96 inches for \$209. Wendy (and Mark) felt that this was a really good price. So, as a result of this discussion, Faith plans on buying two bolts which will be charged to the guild for the purpose of making charity quilts.**
- 3. Faith and Sue went through the fabric she had and arranged the fabric by colour. On Saturday, this fabric will be cut and put into kits. Each kit will include a pattern.**
- 4. Faith informed us that the Beachburg long term care home is in need of lots of wheelchair as well as single bed quilts. She has three patterns for the single bed quilts and one simple pattern for the wheel chair quilts. Connie also mentioned that the Columbus House is in need of baby or crib quilts. Wendy says she thinks she has three wheelchair quilts and a few single bed quilts already made. Wendy will look to see what she has. Joyce has several pieces of flannel to donate for crib quilts. Cynthia mentioned that she was contacted by a veterinarian from Cobden who would like quilts to give to owners of pets who have passed away.**
- 5. Faith asked about labels for these charity quilts. Wendy said she has some but Dawn had most because she would put them on while she did the binding. Wendy said that they made a couple of hundred of these labels and so there should be more than enough.**
- 6. Faith was wondering if a Treasurer's Report could be included in our Guild meetings. Wendy said she could do that...although there aren't many changes. Wendy said she would prepare a report for the next meeting.**
- 7. Faith has three January Sew Days – two will be for Charity Quilts. On Saturday, January 14, participants will be getting kits ready. The next Charity Sew Day will be for participants to put the quilt tops together. There will be no charge for participating in Charity Sew Days.**
- 8. Wendy mentioned that she and Dawna are arranging an in-house retreat from March 31 to April 2. She will mention this event at the next guild meeting but will not be taking names until later. She will want everyone's money in advance of the retreat. She is planning on including a blurb about this retreat in the February Newsletter. Faith will also be discussing the barn quilts at our next meeting.**
- 9. Mary-Ann is looking for more Executive Members to complete the President's Challenge. These are going to be included in our Newsletters.**
