June 21, 2022

Denise Kossatz was recognized for receiving the most votes as well as the most donations in the Silent Auction. In the category of Large Hand Quilted Quilts, Jean Ostrom placed first, Connie Daiken second; Jean Ostrom third. In the small hand quilted category, the following quilts were shared: Karen Moore (1st), Denise Kossatz (2nd) and Marg LaCroix (3rd). In the Small Machine Quilted category, Karen Moore shared her first place prize winning quilt and Helen McGregor shared hers which placed second. Finally, Erin Harvey shared her quilt which placed first in the Large Machine Quilted Category.
8. Cynthia kicked off Faith Van Dam's 2022-2023 Programming by distributing a quilt block card for each of us to make. It was decided that we would use scrap fabric and we would all make a 12 inch block following the measurements on our card.
