

## Minutes of Pembroke Log Cabin Quilters

November 15, 2022

1. Mary-Ann Vanner called the meeting to order at 7 pm. Twenty-seven (27) were in attendance in-person and fourteen (14) were in attendance on zoom.
2. Faith Van Dam introduced our guest speaker, Kelly Dumaresq. Kelly began quilting in 1997 and has become known as a scrappy quilt queen!
3. Kelly Dumaresq describes herself as a traditional quilter and she identifies as a teacher first and a quilter last. She proceeded to share a number of her scrappy quilts with many enlightening anecdotes. The following were the quilts she presented:
  - “Journey of a Quilter” with the back containing many of her “orphan blocks”
  - The quilt her great-grandmother gave her – her inspiration
  - A zig-zag quilt
  - Twisted Log Cabin – which is known as “The Quilt” in her household
  - Trail Mix which is a free pattern from “allpeoplequilt.com”
  - Farm Girl Vintage by Lori Holt
  - From the Drawers Quilt
  - Strip Quilt – 2.5” x 4.5” rectangles
  - Sprigs and Twigs quilt by Kim Diehl
  - Log Cabin Quilt with flying guss
  - Waves of Love quilt with half square triangles – she used “easy angle” and companion angle rulers
  - Star Quilt
  - Snowball Quilt
  - Blue Jays Quilt – Blue Jay Season 2017
  - Border Creek Station Quilt (Stash Buster)
  - Hour Glass Quilt - A block exchange quilt
  - Fair and Square Quilt – by Bonnie Hunter
  - Old Tobacco Road – Bonnie Hunter – check Quilt Ville Leaders and Enders by Bonnie Hunter
  - Purple Quilt of her leaders and enders
  - “Summer at the Lake”
  - Building Block Blues
  - My Checkered Past
  - Double 9-patch quilt separated nicely by sashing
  - Home Grown Library
  - Strippy Log Cabin – which she did as a quilt as you go quilt
  - A sampler she created using Jody Barrow’s “square in a square” technique
  - “Miss Rosie’s Farmyard Favourites” – sampler – quilt the book
  - “Sew in Love” – pattern by Laundry Basket
  - “My Little World” quilt
  - Hand work: hexagon quilt – 2016 was a year in hexies
  - Blue Jay Schedule – dark blue shoes games the Jays won and light blue when they lost

- O' Canada – begun during Canada's 150<sup>th</sup> in 2017
