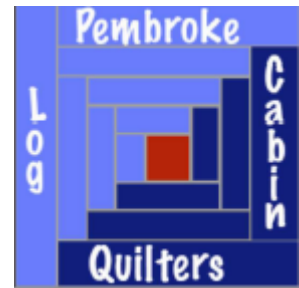

Some details coming out :

✂ **Prizes this year** : 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> - no category. Folks walking about ... they vote on what they liked - regardless of category, size, appliqué, pieced, etc.

✂ **Publicity Postcards** should be back from the printers, the reveal at the Tuesday's meeting.

✂ **President's Challenge** .. Make a 'Do Not Touch' mini quilt. The purpose is to display MANY of these about the Quilt Show emphasizing to "Not touch the quilts". Google online for ideas.. Size : 12" sq to a max of 16" sq. Bring out your sense of humour. Faith will pick the winner - who will get bragging rights! Your name published in the Newsletter, on our Webpage.

✂ **Fat Quarter Project** .. Northcott has once again donated fat quarters. A bundle of 3 co-ordinating Fat Quarters are available for \$10. Sew up a project, donate for a Silent Auction at the Quilt Show. Monies belong to the Guild and help fund our Guild meeting events. Erin will have bundles available for sale.

✂ **Raffle Tickets** .. Each member is expected to sell 2 booklets of tickets. A Booklet contains 10 tickets; price \$2 ea or 3/\$5. (Is there a special price for a complete booklet ??) Erin will have the tickets available at the November meeting. The winner receives a hand-quilted quilt donated by a mystery person.

✂ **Quilt Handler** .. Cat Fisher is well seasoned at this position. She co-ordinates the receiving / pickup of quilts being displayed in the show. Not an easy task. Initially she is asking for anyone who is submitting a large quilt to complete the necessary paperwork. At this time there is a limit of 3 large quilts / quilter.

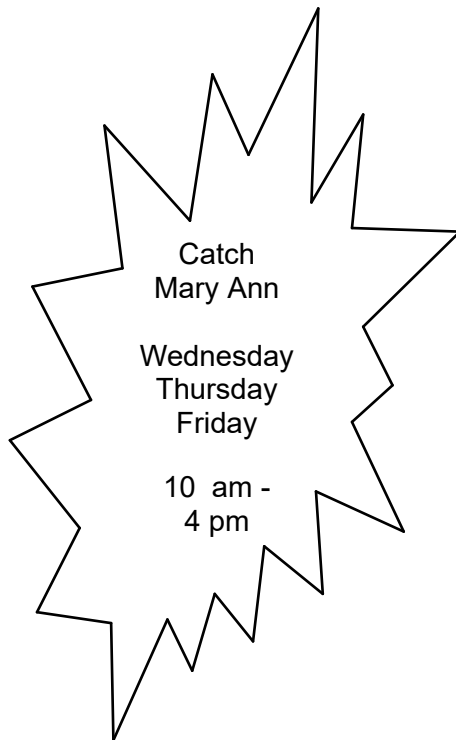
